

Bahraich (Agency): Five workers died allegedly after inhaling fumes emanating from a dryer at a rice mill here on Friday, police said. Three other workers, who fainted after inhaling the fumes, were rushed to the district hospital, Additional Superintendent of Police, Ramanand Prasad Kushwaha, The incident took place at the Rajgarhia Rice Mill and preliminary investigations suggest that several workers arrived at the mill this morning and went to inspect smoke emanating from the dryer, the officer said.

Omar Abdullah backs Centre's move to suspend **Indus Waters Treaty**

New Delhi (Agency): Jammu and Kashmir chief minister Omar Abdullah, on Friday, called the nowsuspended Indus Waters Treaty with Pakistan the "most unfair document" for the people of the union territory, saying it never had their support. India on Wednesday suspended the World Bank brokered 1960 treaty on water sharing with Pakistan in response to the terrorist attack in Jammu and Kashmir's Pahalgam that killed 26 people.

More than 96% of prisoners pass UP **Board Class 12 exams**

The UP Board's list indicates that 94 prisoners from 32 jails across UP appeared in the Intermediate examination, with 91 of them passing

In an impressive result, 91 out of 94 prisoners who appeared for the Uttar Pradesh Board of Secondary Education's Class 12 examination from different jails across the state have passed the examination.

According to information revealed in the list released by the UP Board on Friday, the Agra jail saw the highest participation with 17 prisoners appearing for the Intermediate (Class 12) exams and all of them clearing it.

Similarly, all eight prisoners from the Lucknow jail who took the examination passed. Besides, all five prisoners from Rampur and all nine from Bareilly achieved success in the Intermediate exams.

The UP Board's list indicates

that 94 prisoners from 32 jails across UP appeared in Intermediate examination, with 91 of them passing, resulting in an

impressive overall pass percentage of 96.81 per cent the incarcerated candidates at this level. However, the performance

of prisoners in the High School examination was comparatively lower. While all 10 prisoners from Ghaziabad and all 10 from Varanasi jails passed the High School exams, only 16 out of 21 prisoners from Agra and nine out of 13 from Bareilly were successful.

Overall, 105 prisoners from 32 jails appeared in the High School examination, with 91 of them passing, resulting in a pass percentage of 86.67 per cent for prisoners at the High School level.

Former ISRO chief K Kasturirangan dies at 84

New Delhi (Agency): Former ISRO chief and chairperson of drafting committee behind the ambitious new National Education Policy (NEP) K Kasturirangan passed away in Bengaluru on Friday, officials said. He was 84.

"He left for heavenly abode this morning at his residence in Bengaluru. His body will be kept at Raman Research Institute (RRI) for paying last respects on April 27," the officials said. Known as the man behind education reforms listed in NEP, Kasturirangan had served as

chancellor of the Jawaharlal Nehru University and chairman of the Karnataka Knowledge Commission. He had also served as a member of the Rajya Sabha (2003–09) and as member of then Planning Commission of India. Kasturirangan was also the Director of the National Institute of Advanced Studies, Bangalore from April 2004 to 2009.

Ial Shakti minister CR Paatil

'Won't allow a single drop of water into Pakistan'

New Delhi (Agency): Jal Shakti minister CR Paatil on Friday said that India would not allow a "single drop" of water to flow into Pakistan as a retaliation for its alleged role in the terrorist attack on tourists in Jammu and Kashmir's Pahalgam, killing 26 innocent people.

"We will ensure that not a single drop of water flows into Pakistan from India," CR Paatil said.

The minister made the comments after attending a meeting chaired by home minister Amit Shah to discuss the future course of action following India's decision to suspend the Indus Waters Treaty of 1960 with Pakistan.

Besides Paatil, senior officials from several ministries reportedly attended the high-stakes meeting.

Paatil also said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has issued a slew of



directives, and the meeting was held to follow up on them. Shah also made several suggestions to ensure the effective implementation of the Centre's decision.

Paatil later posted on X, "The Modi government's historic decision on the



Indus Waters Treaty is lawful and in national interest. We will ensure that not a single drop of Indus water flows into Pakistan."

The BJP leader also said India has sent a "strong message" to Pakistan that it will not tolerate terrorism at all.

Earlier on Friday, Jammu and Kashmir chief minister Omar Abdullah called the nowsuspended treaty the "most unfair document" for the people of the union territory, saying it never had their support. Over 8 lakh shops in Delhi remain shut in protest against **Pahalgam** terror attack

New Delhi (Agency): Over 900 markets in Delhi were shut down on Friday in protest against the terrorist attack in Pahalgam, leading to a trade loss of ₹1,500 crore in one day, According to the Confederation of All India Traders (CAIT), more than 8 lakh shops across the national capital participated in the bandh, spanning key sectors such as textiles, gold, spices, utensils and more. The bandh had been called by the Chamber of Trade and Industry (CTI). "This is more than just a protest. It's a united stand against terrorism, we are observing this bandh in memory of those who lost their lives in Pahalgam."

Rupee rises 12 paise to 85.33 against dollar



MUMBAI: After a two-day pause, the rupee gained 12 paise to 85.33 against the US dollar on Thursday, on weak greenback and overnight decline in crude oil

Forex traders said the rupee strengthened on the weak US dollar and overnight decline in crude oil prices amid slowing US business activity. The US Treasury yields also declined with the 10-year yield falling

3 bps to 4.35 per cent. At the interbank foreign exchange, the domestic unit opened at 85.60 and moved between the intra-day high of 85.25 and the low of 85.67 against the greenback.

'Patent filings by startups,

MSMEs up 310% in 5 years'

NEW DELHI: Patent filings by startups and MSMEs have increased by 310 per cent in the last 5 years from 1,492 in 2018-19 to 6,120 in 2023-24, an official said on Thursday.

N Ramchander, Joint Controller, Controller General of Patents, Designs and Trademarks, further shared that in about three years over 2.4 million students and faculty across India have been educated about IP rights through the National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission launched in 2021.

Addressing an event organised by ASSOCHAM, he informed that the filing of patent applications in India has surged by 116 per cent rising from 42,763 in 2014-15 to 92,172 in 2023-24.

"Patent grants have been

an even more remarkable increase of 1,624 per cent, jumping from 5,978 in 2014-15 to 103,057 in 2023-24. India has seen biggest change in resident and non-resident distribution over past 10 years with the share of resident filling increasing from 24.8 per cent in 2013 to 60 per cent in 2024," said N Ramchander.

India's IPR policy has provided a comprehensive framework for IP creation, protection and commercialisation but continuous evaluation and updation are necessary. The patent rules have been amended in 2024 in order to further simplify and streamline the procedure and create conducive environment for innovation and protection of Intellectual Property (IP) in India.

Big 204 percent jump in the value of M&A and PE deals on an annual basis



New Delhi (Agency): The value of mergers and acquisitions (M&A) and private equity (PE) deals in India in the first quarter of 2025 has registered a big jump of 204 percent on an annual basis. There were 67 deals in the January-March period and their value was \$ 5.3 billion. This information was given in the Grant Thornton India report released on Thursday. According to the report, six high-value transactions of more than \$ 100 million also took place in this quarter, with a total value of \$ 4.3 billion. In the previous quarter, there were only four deals of more than \$ 100 million and their value was \$ 534 million.

The report said that this trend reflects renewed confidence among investors, establishing India as a preferred destination for capital investment amid

global uncertainties. Vishal Aggarwal of Grant Thornton India said, despite global challenges and volatility in capital markets, India's growth rate remains promising. emphasis on regulatory simplification collaborative development in Budget 2025, we expect capital expenditure to accelerate, leading to fresh capital inflows. EVs could be the game-changer India needs

rn 2024, over 80 million birvanis were delivered by just one app-based food delivery service across India. Similarly, small businesses across the country and rural India - much of which is dependent on agriculture – are also on the move. Like the digital retail sector, farmers and micro-entrepreneurs need sustainable mobility options that can help move goods around quickly, cleanly, inexpensively, and efficiently. That's where India's Electric Vehicle (EV) targets can play a key role, aiming for 80 per cent of two- and threewheelers to be electric by 2030, along with 40 per cent of buses and 30 per cent of private cars. Although ambitious, meeting these EV targets could not only help boost economic activity by making it easier to get around India's busy cities, but also make transportation cleaner, reduce air pollution, and strengthen India's energy

To unlock this potential, India's EV sector will need to address significant challenges related to general automobile components, batteries, and charging stations through a combination of policy and financial incentives to create both supply and demand. This, in turn, will send a clear signal about the country's move towards a complete EV value chain and really help shift the needle. The good news is that much of this is already in the works and, if it takes off, the payoff will be significant: the transition to EVs in India could be worth an estimated \$206 billion by 2030 (according to the CEEW Centre for Energy Finance) and generate as many as 50 million direct and indirect jobs (IVCA—EY—Induslaw report).

On the demand side, consider how electrifying bus fleets across the country could be a major game-changer. There are an estimated 2 million buses on India's roads today, many operated by private operators. Putting in place better financing incentives and innovative business models, along with charging infrastructure, could help transform these fleets. Doing so would reduce petrol and diesel costs for operators, enhance the experience for customers, and improve local air quality: a triple win. Along with efforts to support the shift for larger forms of transportation – buses as well as private vehicles – there are also exciting financing solutions for two- and threewheelers. The International Finance Corporation is exploring debt and equity solutions that could help operators expand their electric bus and truck fleets. We have also made equity investments in companies such as Mahindra Last Mile Mobility, a subsidiary of Mahindra & Mahindra, to support expansion into the EV threewheeler segment, and Napino, to help grow its electronics and EV component manufacturing capacity. We are also investing in funds that support Indian companies to grow the two-wheeler EV market domestically, as well as create local jobs and strengthen India's role in global EV supply chains.

On the supply side, consider batteries. India has historically relied on importing EV battery cells from other countries, but this is set to change. According to some estimates, in just the next five years, 13 per cent of India's EV battery cell demand could be sourced domestically, up from close to 0 per cent today. In the government's most recent Budget, import duties were eliminated on a range of materials that make the lithiumion batteries which power EVs – effectively a push to boost domestic battery makers. Relatedly, concerted investments in charging infrastructure across both urban and rural areas will also be needed in order to boost uptake. The government's Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of (Hybrid and) Electric Vehicles, or FAME scheme, could support the buildout of this charging infrastructure, including both slow and fast charging solutions, to meet the needs of a growing market. Beyond its borders, India's EV transformation offers an exciting inflexion point for the industry more widely. The right moves now could send a major signal to the market. For instance, joint ventures between domestic industry or battery manufacturers and international firms are an obvious next step to meet growing national and international demand.

The private sector is driving China's global dominance

mid-February this year, President Xi Jinping met China's private business leaders at a symposium in Beijing. Many of the participants were from technology companies which, according to the Communist Party of China's formulation, were entities under the new development philosophy (xin fazhan linian). As per this philosophy, economic development prioritises quality rather than quantity, and stresses on innovation, coordination, being environment-friendly, transparency. The ensuing highquality development seeks to push China up the global value chain.

According to China's State Administration of Market Regulation, as of 2024, there are over 55 million private companies in the country. The private sector accounts for over 50 per cent of tax revenue, over 60 per cent of GDP, over 70 per cent of technological innovation, over 80 per cent of urban employment, and over 90 per cent of the total number of enterprises (in comparison, India's private sector has a share of 36 per cent in tax revenue, 91 per cent of GDP, 36 per cent in technological innovation, 11 per cent in employment, and over 95 per cent of the total number of registered enterprises).

One of the important points emphasised by Xi at the symposium was for the companies to embrace patriotism. This was further

underscored by Premier Li Qiang in his Work Report at the annual session of the National People's Congress in March, calling upon the companies to refine their corporate systems and assert their distinctive Chinese identity. This vote of confidence from the income economies. They are also involved in diverse internationalisation efforts across value chain segments, such as establishing local manufacturing, sales, and service operations. According to China's General Administration of Customs,



Chinese leadership is an acknowledgement of the rising importance of the country's private capital, and their role in not only driving domestic development but also providing wind to China's global sails. An apt illustration is the unveiling of two open-source models by the Chinese Artificial Intelligence company, DeepSeek, challenging the dominance of American rivals such as OpenAI, Meta and Google (DeepSeek's CEO Liang Wenfeng was also at the symposium). Chinese outbound investment is now increasingly driven by the expansion of private companies with global ambitions, whose focus has shifted towards emerging markets rather than high-

Chinese private enterprises contributed to foreign trade with transactions totalling 24.33 trillion yuan (about US\$3.4 trillion) in 2024. Chinese private companies, with their sleek and sophisticated products, have been able to connect with global consumers and are pivotal entities in building an 'industrial diplomacy' – to borrow the phrase from sociologist Kyle Chan - to reshape global production networks and make them centred around Beijing. This is visible in a range of modern sectors and industries, that are qualitatively superior and critical in a technologically interconnected world, such as Electric Vehicles, consumer electronics and digital

gadgets, lithium batteries, and solar panels. Chinese private companies form vital nodes in global supply chains in these industries, and their inextricability is used by Beijing for competitive advantage. Through these companies, China has remained attentive to building backward and forward industrial linkages – making components and specialised machinery, along with developing skilled personnel with the technical know-how - and holistically dominates the wider ecosystem while also guarding against the sharing of technology. The ability of Chinese smartphone companies to endure and build a loyal consumer base in a country like India (given the hostile geopolitical equation) is a testament to their adaptive

The attractiveness of Chinese investments, especially in the developing world, places Beijing in an advantageous position. This is well visible in its competition with India, whose manufacturing sector's scale and development trajectory bears similarities to that of the Chinese experience. In recent months, China has weaponised its strategic leverage in supply chains - by curbing its specialised machinery and limiting the mobility of its citizens who are engineers and technical staff working at supplier facilities - to slow down India's industrial production, especially in electronics. While India is making strenuous efforts to become a viable

manufacturing corporations, its ambitions are also intertwined with dependence on China for nuts and bolts. While aware of its entanglement, India has begun taking key steps in the medium-tolonger term with an emphasis on creating indigenous electronics suppliers and achieving selfsufficiency in manufacturing components. It is difficult to discount China and its private companies. However, the tariff wars initiated by the Trump administration, primarily targeting China – who have retaliated in kind have provided avenues for Chinese manufactured goods to get diverted into India and raised apprehensions of dumping. The resultant impact on India's domestic industries, in turn, hurts the country's manufacturing ambitions. India's Economic Survey 2023-24 had identified the need to address this vulnerability but also simultaneously collaborate with Chinese investment and technology to boost domestic manufacturing capabilities.

In effect, to plug India into the global supply chain, it was inevitable to be plugged into China's supply chain.

While New Delhi has taken steps to engage with all domestic stakeholders in responding to rising global trade tensions, it will have to walk a tightrope by engaging with both Washington DC and Beijing, given the complexities in the economic and trade ecosystem.

All the claims of the Central Government in Jammu and Kashmir are baseless

It is a judgment landmark strengthening federalism as the basis for the Indian Constitution — the "Union of States" concept enshrined in law. Our founding fathers wrote the Constitution as a vision statement of how we govern ourselves rather than an operational manual. This has required a lot of interpretation and operationalisation over time — a fact attested in the more than 100 amendments we have had in the last 75 years, as well as several landmark Supreme Court judgments.

Since 2014, capitalising on the operational grey areas in the Constitution, the Union government has attempted an unprecedented centralisation of power along with constant interference in the functioning of democratically elected state governments — most often through the appointment of obdurate governors to states where the NDA has not been

elected to office. Such actions have led to multiple states approaching the Supreme Court seeking justice, or at least reprieve, from the actions of their governors. For example, Kerala has had to take its Governor to court. Punjab did the same and won — including for a matter as routine as the Governor interfering with the convening of the Assembly session. This judgment, based on a similar litigation by Tamil Nadu concerning 10 bills that the Governor had held in abeyance for years, greatly limits the ability of governors to obstruct state legislation, and thereby removes a lacuna in the procedural implementation of Constitution, which has been exploited unscrupulously in the past. Judgments like this refine the interpretations of the Constitution and provide operating guidelines. At one level, this is a simple extension of the judgment delivered by the SC in November 2023 in State of Punjab vs Principal Secretary to the Governor of Punjab and Another, where it reaffirmed that in a parliamentary democracy, real

power lies with elected representatives, and that the Governor cannot indefinitely withhold his assent to bills or obstruct the legislative process. But at another level, several

aspects of this landmark litigation merit detailed attention. First, the duration for which the 10 bills had been kept pending was an aggravated assault on democracy. The first obstructed bill dates back to 2020, and was passed by the then AIADMK administration. It renamed the Tamil Nadu Fisheries University after the former chief

and immediate governance, not the deep freeze that came from the Governor's inaction.

Second, we must applaud the magnanimity and wisdom of Tamil Nadu's Chief Minister M K Stalin in re-passing all 10 bills verbatim, irrespective of their content or the government (AIADMK or DMK) that had

originally introduced the bill. The Supreme Court's judgment makes a clear distinction: When an identical bill is resubmitted to the Governor, withholding assent becomes constitutionally impermissible: however, an amended bill remains subject to potential rejection again. Our Chief Minister recognised that this matter transcended politics — it was vital to states' rights and federalism. His principled approach secured us a decisive legal victory, as the universal repassing and resubmission of all 10 bills strengthened our case. The third remarkable aspect of this judgment is the Supreme Court's exercise of its extraordinary powers under Article 142 of the Constitution. By declaring these bills as being deemed to have been assented to on the day they arrived at the Governor's desk after re-passing by the Assembly, the Court has taken a decisive step to protect legislative processes from administrative obstruction. While some purists lament the Court's rare foray into executive action, it is beyond any debate that these actions were forced

upon it by the extraordinary actions of the Governor's office throughout the court proceedings — these revealed a troubling pattern of procedural jugglery. When judicial scrutiny was attracted to bills that had languished for years, he hastily returned them to the legislature marked "consent withheld", in an apparent attempt to render the hearing infructuous. After the bills were re-passed, an absurd argument was put forth that because only photocopies were returned while the originals remained at the Raj Bhavan, the legislature lacked authority to repass them.

When the Punjab ruling made it clear that there is no unlimited power to sit on such bills, the repassed bills suddenly got sent to the President for review. At every turn, the Governor tried to subvert both the intent of the legislature and the judicial review of his actions. This has compelled the court to explicitly state in paragraph 432 of the judgment that "The conduct exhibited on part of the Governor.....has been lacking in bonafides."





Ground Zero movie review: Emraan Hashmi's Kashmir drama strikes a much-needed balance in these fraught times

n intensive search-andcombing operation which results in the capture of a dreaded terrorist in Srinagar could be the one-line theme of several similar films in the past. The difference with 'Ground Zero', which calls itself a 'work of fiction based on real-life events', are two-fold. First, it releases the same week of the Pahalgam tragedy, whose consequences will be felt for a long time to come. Second, it steers clear of the disturbing jingoism that has been part and parcel of such films, focussing instead on the tough life of the BSF jawans and other

security forces in the conflict-stricken Kashmir valley Emran Hashmi plays BSF officer Narendra Nath Dhar Dubey, who managed to locate and take out terrorist kingpin Ghazi Baba and his accomplices in 2003. It was a time when PM Atal Bihari Vajpayee had visited the valley, in the midst of rising terrorist activities: there are glimpses of the 2001 attack on Parliament in the film. Delhi-based intelligence officers, played here by Rahul Vora and Zoya Hussain, are not too enthusiastic by Dubey's taking charge and contradicting their findings. Neither is his own senior (Mukesh Tiwari). But Dubev sticks to his guns, trusting his loyal colleagues to have his back, as well as his own gut instincts, and follows through to a successful end. No spoilers here, as these operations are documented in detail. The film uses some of these details to build a complex picture of a valley in turmoil, where the locals can be both complicit and innocent, depending upon their situation. Or let's say, as complex as a mainstream Hindi film can be. It shows locals pelting stones; it also gives us poverty stricken homes where desperate young boys like Hussain

(Mehroos) become easy marks for their handlers from across the border. Yeh jagah hamari hai, par kya yahaan ke log hamaare hain,' asks Dubey; his wounded colleague's (Deepak Paramesh) response is 'yes' to both. It's tempting but not a good idea to extrapolate from films. But Ground Zero, which takes time to build an atmosphere of tension — stepping out to a market, even with your armed mates around you, can be your last day alive — is perhaps the much-needed kind of balance a film can achieve in these fraught times. The film becomes lax in some parts,

especially when the Delhi gang arrives to tell the local forces how to do their jobs. Zoya Hassan pitches it high as an intelligence officer who is willing to lend Dubey her ear; both Vora and Tiwari swing between being shouty and belligerent. Sai Tamhankar is effective as Dubey's wife, getting her own speech in, in defence of her doughty spouse, even as we see how that insecurity creeps into their domestic sphere. Hashmi does a good job of being Dubey, trying to tone down the dialoguing and making it sound conversational. But tighter would have been better.

Fed Cup: Kujur blurs to gold & national record

KOCHI: Odisha sprinter Animesh Kujur ran a blazing 200m race as he won the gold medal with a national record time of 20.40 seconds and became the Asian season leader on the final day of the National Federation Senior Athletics Competition here on Thursday.

The 21-year-old Kujur, who had earlier won a silver in men's 100m, ran a brilliant race to better Amlan Borgohain's earlier national record of 20.52 seconds set in 2022. Borgohain, representing Reliance, finished second with 20.80 seconds.

With his 20.40 seconds effort, Kujur became the current Asian leader and joint 35th best in the world in the season

The men's 200m final race also turned out to be the fastest ever in the country with four competitors running sub 21 seconds. Rahul Kumar G of Tamil Nadu clocked 20.85 seconds to finish third while Manikanta Hoblidhar of Karnataka took the fourth spot with a time of 20.91 seconds.

Kujur, however, missed the World Championships qualifying time of 20.16 seconds which is a very tough ask for an Indian 200m runner.

Asian Championships qualifying time of 20.53 seconds set by the Athletics Federation of India (AFI).

Kujur has been in top form coming into the event. He won a gold in the Uttarakhand National Games in February with a time of 20.58 seconds -- his earlier personal best. He then finished on top in the Indian Open Athletics Meet in Chennai earlier this month, clocking 20.63 seconds.

He had won 200m gold in the last edition of this event, as well as in the 2024 National Inter-State Championships.

"I felt good during the morning heat race. It gave a big boost to my confidence and eventually resulted in a record breaking performance in the medal round," Kujur said after the final race.

In the men's triple jump, Praveen Chithravel equalled his own national record of 17.37m and qualified for the World Championships.



NEW DELHI: The head coach of the India men's cricket team, Gautam Gambhir, has found himself at the centre of a security scare after he received threatening emails, the Delhi Police said on Thursday.

The threats were received on April 22 -- the same day terrorists gunned down 26 people, mostly tourists, in Kashmir's Pahalgam -- from a suspicious Gmail account.

'We have been informed about an alleged threat mail received on an email ID associated with Gautam Gambhir. The matter is being investigated," DCP (Central) M Harsha Vardhan said. "Gautam Gambhir is already a Delhi Police protectee," the officer said. Gambhir, a former BJP MP, reportedly received two threat mails.

Electricity company increased testing fee by seven and a half times

Installing solar net metering system will be costly for consumers

Bhopal (Agency): On one hand, the government in MP is promoting solar energy so that people can produce electricity by installing solar panels on their homes, offices etc. On the other hand, Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company Limited has increased the testing fee charged in solar net metering system by seven and a half times. This increase is a challenge for consumers, as it will increase the cost of installing net metering system. Actually, net metering is a system that adjusts the electricity produced by solar panels with the electricity consumption of your house. If your solar panels generate more electricity than the electricity consumption of your house, then the excess electricity is sent to the grid and you get credit for it.

The increase in the testing fee of solar net metering system will increase the cost of installing solar net metering system for consumers. This may cause problems in

energy. However. government subsidy is also available on solar net metering system in MP, which helps in reducing this cost. But Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company Ltd. has increased the testing fee and made the solar net metering system more expensive, which can harm consumers. There can be many reasons behind Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company Ltd. increasing the testing fee, such as increase in cost, or

It is worth noting that the testing fee of the meter installed in the system has been Rs 1680 and the same fee is fixed in other electricity departments of Madhya Pradesh, West Zone and East Zone, but Madhya Kshetra Bhopal has issued a circular on 4 April 2025 and the fee has been increased to Rs 12450. Whereas a profit of 10 to 15 thousand rupees can be made with great difficulty in a 3 kW solar, but if this circular is accepted, then the vendor will have to close the business or increase the cost of the system instead of working at a loss. At present, the customer says that the cost of the system is high, so how can the rate be increased. Solar vendors have requested Prime Minister Narendra Modi to take cognizance of this issue and help the vendors save their business from closure. The most surprising thing is that the cost of solar net meter is Rs 5448, whereas Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company Limited is charging double the cost of the meter in the name of testing. This fee is Rs 12450. According to sources, electricity distribution companies do not have the right to increase any charge related to electricity. This right is only with the Electricity Regulatory Commission. Vendors will also knock the door of Electricity Regulatory Commission against the order of Madhya Kshetra Vidyut Vitran Company.

Investigation against 'Honourables' in limbo

Bhopal (Agency): The agencies investigating against corruption in MP are so helpless that even after the High Court's direction, the investigation against former ministers and senior officials has not been able to proceed. Due to this, questions have also been raised on the functioning of the Lokayukta and EOW organization. It is worth noting that while on one hand the investigations against former ministers are stuck, on the other hand, a provision has been made that investigation cases will not be easily registered against ministers in the Lokayukta. On receiving a complaint, it will first be examined whether the minister has a direct role in the concerned matter or not. What happens now is that on examining the complaint, if the basis for registering an investigation case is understood at first glance, then the case is registered, but it is not looked into closely as to what is the role of the minister in it. Due to this, after investigation, action has to be taken against the minister for deletion and termination. This creates a situation of unnecessary dispute. Therefore, it has been decided to implement a new system. that the investigation agencies were established to catch organized, whitecollar crime. District police is enough to catch small employees like Patwari, Panchayat Secretary. It seems that somewhere the investigation agencies also work under pressure. This is the reason why big fish always escape.

In August 2022, while hearing a PIL, the High Court had directed the Lokayukta to investigate the property of the then minister Gaurishankar Bisen. The PIL was filed by former MLA of Lanji (Balaghat) Kishore Samarite. A complaint of benami property worth billions of rupees was made to the Lokayukta against Minister Govind Singh Rajput, but the investigation did not start. Samrite, who complained against Bisen, said that when the Lokavukta organization did not start the investigation on the complaint made in the year 2013, he filed a petition in the High Court.

Devendra Yadav cornered BJP over Delhi's public transport

Delhi (Agency): Delhi Congress President Devendra Yadav has expressed serious concern over the poor condition of public transport facilities. He said that during the tenure of the BJP government, Delhi's transport facilities have completely deteriorated. Especially in this scorching heat and deadly heat wave, when lakhs of people are dependent on public buses, the passengers are facing a lot of problems due to the huge shortage of DTC buses and the absence of shelters at the bus stops. Devendra Yadav said that the Delhi government has not only failed to improve the public transport facilities, but more than 2000 DTC buses have been removed from the fleet during its tenure. He also questioned the Chief Minister's announcement, in which it was said that 1000 e-buses would be included in the first week of April, but not even a single bus has been included till now. He also cited the Delhi High Court's order, in which 11,000 DTC buses were said to be necessary in the capital. But, while there were 4344 DTC buses in 2015-16, it reduced to 3937 in 2022-23. During the Congress government, the number of buses was more than 7000 and during the tenure of the Sheila Dikshit government, a big step was taken towards pollution control by introducing CNG buses, which was appreciated internationally.
